

SUB: ADHERENCE OF PROVISIONS OF RIGHT TO EDUCATION ACT, 2009 AND AFFILIATION BYE-LAWS OF BOARD – REG.

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) grants affiliation to the schools on fulfillment of requirements laid down in Bye-laws of Affiliation. It is imperative on the part of the schools to comply not only with provisions of Affiliation and Examination Bye-laws of CBSE but also the provisions contained in the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and concerned State Education Acts.

The provisions in the RTE Act, 2009 and the State Education Acts have been framed specifically keeping in mind the academic betterment and safety and security of the school children. It has come to the notice of the Board that schools are showing a lax attitude towards the provisions contained in these enactments regarding academic betterment as well as the safety & security of students.

The following points are required to be adhered to by all the affiliated schools in letter and spirit.

1. The schools are required to have valid copy of Recognition certificate as stipulated in Section 18(1) of Right to Education Act, 2009. In case, the schools have not obtained the recognition certificate from the State Education Department, the same may be applied for and obtained immediately.
2. The schools shall not operate from multiple plots of land and desist from shifting the sites, change of names and running in multiple shifts without due approvals from the concerned State/UT Governments and the Board.
3. The schools shall ensure that the buildings in which the schools are running are compliant with the provisions given in the National Building Code and the guidelines issued by National Disaster Management Authority.
4. The schools shall ensure that they have upto date building safety certificate, fire safety certificate, health & sanitation certificate and drinking water safety certificate from competent Government authorities.
5. The school shall ensure that provisions of the RTE Act, 2009 and State Education acts are being complied with meticulously.

The Heads and Managers of schools are directed to take note of the above and also bring it to the knowledge of school managing committee. In case of violation of any statutory provisions or the relevant rules or Bye-laws of the Board, the Board will be constrained to take necessary action against the school which may extend to disaffiliation of the school.


