With reference to your email. you have informed to send the *detailed report* regarding conducting the battery of test between 6th to 8th standard students in the scheme of World Beaters Talent Contest for the year 2017-2018.. The following are the details of this Scheme :-

This Scheme was started from the year 2002-2003 as per G.O.(Ms.)No.130, School Education Department, dated 20.08.2002.

Aim of the Scheme :

- Battery of tests to discover the motor quality in childrens studying in VI,, VII and VIII in all schools in Tamilnadu . This motor quality help to identity speed, endurance, strength explosive power and agility levels in a children and also indicate the child's potential to play a particular game/spot

- The battery of test in the pattern specified by the modified report card shall be conducted each term [three time in a year] to enable the student to assess his/her progress
- The batter of test' may be conducted in the PT period according to the convenience of the school
- The report card in the modified format should be issued to the parents each term.
- To improve community health and fitness and to achieve excellence at the sporting arena, a comprehensive programme with mass participation in sports is implemented under "World Beaters Talent Spotting Scheme" (WBTSS) which will imbibe a sports culture.
- Under WBTSS, battery of tests are conducted for students studying in 6th, 7th and 8th standards to identify the motor qualities such as speed, strength, endurance, agility and explosive power of the students to determine their suitability to a particular game / sport and assess their budding talents to become a future elite sportsperson. Coaching camps are conducted throughout the State for mass participation.
- Initially, all the schools are supposed to conduct battery of tests for students studying in 6th, 7th and 8th standards through Physical Education Teachers in every year from June onwards and after conducting the tests, issue report cards to the students by indicating their performance in the battery of tests by awarding marks in order to motivate the individual as well as parents. The school authorities are required to send the details of such results to the District Sports and Youth Welfare Officers of the concerned districts who in turn send the reports to the SDAT.
- The Government had sanctioned a sum of Rs.14.38 Lakhs under the World Beaters Talent Spotting Scheme for the conduct of Educational Level Competitions and Regional Level Competitions for the year 2017-2018.

- In this Scheme, the battery of test for the year 2017-2018 was completed in all the schools in all the districts. The next phase of the scheme is to conduct the Educational District Level Competition for boys and girls, who scored 9 or 8 marks out of 10 marks.

The competition was conducted between boys and girls in the standard 6th to 8th. as follows:-

:Athletics – for Boys and Girls –VI/ / VI / VIII standard

100 Mts Run
200 Mts Run
400 Mts Run
Long Jump
High Jump
Shotput

Educational District Level Competition was conducted and amount released as follows:

- Educational District Level Competition was conducted in all districts at a cost of Rs.11,680 per Educational district [67 Educational District in October/November, x Rs.11,680/- = Rs.7,82,660/-
- Amount was released to conduct the Regional Level Competition in nine regions as follows:

- Besides the above, the students who obtained first 10 places in the Educational District Competitions are selected for the Non-Residential Coaching Camp for 5 days in each Educational Districts across the districts in the State. During this camp, they will be given snacks for 5 days and participation certificates at the end of the camp. These Non-Residential Coaching Camps will be conducted by the PETs/experts/prominent players along with the help of the SDAT Coaches in

districts. Likewise, 60 outstanding talents (30 boys / 30 girls) from each Educational District will be selected based on their performance in the WBTS Scheme for attending the 15 days Residential Coaching Camp in each District Headquarters wherein they will be provided the following :-

1. Dietary charges @ Rs.100/- per player for 15 days.
2. Uniform @ Rs.300/- per player.
3. Participation Certificates

- The ability of the athletes is assessed and depending upon their skills, players are sent to various Academies of different disciplines. For eg., for motor qualities of speed, the players are selected for the Sprint and Jump Academy, for endurance to the Middle and Long Distance Academy and for strength to the Throws Academy, etc., The performance of the students are noted and are ranked according to their potential.
- Battery of tests to discover the motor quality in children studying in VI, VII and VIII in all schools in Tamilnadu . This motor quality help to identify speed, endurance strength explosive power and agility levels in a children and also indicate the child's potential to play a particular game/spot
- After attending the regional level of competition in the month of Feb. or March, the players who scored top rank were selected and admitted in the specialized academies coaching camp and to give proper training to athletes with the help of specialized coaches in the respective discipline [Spring and Jump, Middle and Distance and Throws at various districts] to achieve International Level competition. and also given training in the next level players in other disciplines like Swimming, Football and Hockey .This camp will conducted once in four month . on the time of the camp players should get TA/DA Accommodation, Medical treatment should be provided to the player who were injure on the time camp and also provide proper diet to the players for entire camp period and proper uniform will be provided once in a year..

- In the Regional Level competitions, the players who secured first 10 places, Scholarship amount was released of 500/- per month to per player x 12months = Rs.6,000/- per annum for a total of 360 players in 9 regions as follows:

- After obtaining the results of the Regional level Competitions, a State level Selection Trials for two or three days will be conducted for the students the students who will be selected for getting training in the specialized coaching camps in the above Academies in the Quarterly/Half-Yearly/Annual Holidays every year. The students attending coaching camps in Specialized Academies will be given scientific training, uniform, sports kits, TA/DA for actual no. of stays, etc. The students of these Specialized Academies are given training with an aim to secure medals at the international level competitions.
- After attending the regional level of competition in the month of Feb. or March, the players who scored top rank were selected and admitted in the specialized academies coaching camp and to give proper training to athletes with the help of specialized coaches in the respective discipline [Spring and Jump, Middle and Distance and Throws at various districts] to achieve International Level competition. and also given training in the next level players in other disciplines like Swimming, Football and Hockey .This camp will conducted once in four month . on the time of the camp players should get TA/DA Accommodation, Medical treatment should be provided to the player who were injure on the time camp and also

provide proper diet to the players for entire camp period and proper uniform will be provided once in a year..
