I have been given the privilege of functioning as the President of the School Sports Promotion Foundation for Tamil Nadu.

The School Sports Promotion Foundation is a non-profit philanthropic trust for sports promotion and is committed to promoting a National Movement in sports for schools and colleges. It was launched in on August 23, 2015 by the Secretary, Government of India and Director, General Sports Authority of India. It has on its Governing Council, International Sports Stars such as Baichung Bhutia (former captain Indian Football team), Om Prakash (former Captain Indian Volleyball team) Charles Borromeo (Asian Games Gold Medallist Athletics) and others and is headed by Shri. Om Pathak, a former IAS officer and ex-serviceman himself.

In the current season, 200 top sports talent in Tamil Nadu in the age group of 10 to 15 years are to be identified through competitions. In all, 160 tournaments are to be conducted in 32 districts of Tamil Nadu in 5 sports disciplines by qualified officials and coaches. Following this, five state championships in these sports disciplines are to be conducted at the state level by qualified technical officials. The five disciplines that have been chosen are Athletics, Football, Volleyball, Basketball and Cricket. SSPF is a sports movement which is now into its third season.

Following the state level Championship, there will be a National level championship for each discipline and the best among the Talent seen will be chosen for further development. Each discipline will have its own Centre of Excellence and the best performing sports persons and athletes will be trained. Once chosen based on individual performances, they will be provided with

100% scholarship for the remaining school years. SSPF will also arrange for coaching and if necessary provide them accommodation in the best residential schools identified for this purpose.

Following this brief introduction, it would help us greatly if the School Education Department can help us in the following manner:

- 1) Instructions to CEOs/DEOs for all Government schools to register for season 3 (this is the third year). Currently, very few Government schools are registered as there is a registration fee. If instructions are given, they would be in a position to register. For each school, it is Rs.2000/- for each discipline of Athletics, Volleyball, Basketball and Football. For Cricket, it is Rs 5,000/-. All other expenses of conduct of the meet at the District and State and National level is borne by SSPF and will not cost the schools any other expenditure. They can choose the disciplines that they are interested in. The registrations across the country have begun and we are very keen that TN should not miss out on this opportunity.
- 2) Also, would it be possible for an MOU between the SSPF and the School Education Department which will make the cooperation seamless? If so, we could submit a draft MOU for your kind consideration.
- 3) I have enclosed a copy of the Ministry of Human Resources Development just for information.

We look forward to working with you as this will help really talented sports children to get into the best institutions at the right age and develop their talent.
