Sub: School Education –HCL Technologies Ltd.-“Tech Bee – Early Career Training Program” – One year Training to students who have scored 85% aggregate and above in XII Public Examination and placement thereafter – Encouraging students to join - Reg.

With reference to the letter cited above, HCL Technologies. ELCOT, SEZ, Sholinganallur, Chennai-600119 has requested the Government to recommend deserving students who have secured 85% and above in Mathematics or Business Mathematics in XII Public Examination for one year training to be organized by HCL Technologies under “Tech Bee – Early Career Training Program”.

It is informed that they are gearing up to launch the next batch of “**Tech Bees - An Early Career Training Program**” and said that the first set of 200 candidates who have currently completed their training successfully, and are in the process of beginning their careers with HCL. They are looking for young talent from the state of Tamil Nadu, with a 85% and above in Mathematics or Business Mathematics in Class XII board examinations. The students who are selected to be a part of this program is awarded a stipend of INR 10,000 per month, through the entire duration of their 12-month training and are also awarded, Diploma in Engineering upon successful completion of this course.

It is also informed that upon successful completion of training, the students will commence their IT careers with HCL, and will be eligible to draw a salary of INR 2.2 lakh per annum. They acknowledge the students’ long term educational and career -related aspirations, and also provide opportunities for them to pursue higher education (E.g.: MCA/M.SC (IT) from recognized universities while they are on the job simultaneously. The fees structure for this program is designed in such a way that the students are not required to make any payment while joining this program, and optionally, can also become eligible for 100% scholarship, if they perform to the desired levels during their one -year training.

The Tech Bee program is open for admissions now with batches in Chennai and Madurai scheduled to commence in June, 2019. Considering the unconventional nature of this program, they believe that a direct outreach to the targeted students via student / parent counseling initiatives would be viable in providing awareness and support for integration of deserving candidates with the program.

Hence, all the Chief Educational Officers are requested to inform all the Headmasters of the Government and Government Aided Higher Secondary Schools to identify and recommend the interested. Eligible and deserving candidates to join this program. The candidates may directly send their requisition along with their Bio- Date to HCL, Chennai at the earliest to the contact details given below.


