I am directed to enclose a copy of the Government of India's letter in the reference cited with its enclosures wherein the Additional Secretary to Government Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Drinking water sanitation has stated that, the Sujlam 2.0 campaign was launched on World Water Day, 22.03.2022 in partnership with Ministry of Education, D/o School Education and Literacy, as a step forward towards the global theme of this year 'Groundwater – to make the invisible visible', following the principles of 3Rs viz., Reduce, Reuse and Recharge.

2. The Prime focus of the Sujlam 2.0 campaign is to prioritize village with 100% Functional Household Tap Connections (FHTCs) under Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) and saturate villages with Grey Water management. The campaign also focuses on creation of community and institution-level greater management assets, such as soak pits, leach pit, magic pits or kitchen gardens in campaign mode to promote complete saturation at Panchyat Ghars, Health Care Facilities, Schools, Community Centres and other public institutions.\

3. For successful implementation of the Sujlam 2.0 campaign, Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Drinking water sanitation has also issued a Joint Advisory dated 21<sup>st</sup> March 2022, signed by Ministry of Jal Shakti, Department of Drinking Water and Sanitation, Department of School Education and Literacy and M/o Panchyat Raj, to the Chief Secretaries of all the States/UTs.


