IMPORTANT NOTE TO PRIVATE CANDIDATES**

**REGARDING PRACTICAL EXAMINATION:**

**1) Already Appeared in Old Pattern (1200 Marks)**

Candidates should necessarily secure minimum 030 Marks out of 150 in Theory Examination and 040 Marks out of 050 in Practical Examination in the subjects involving practical, in order to pass the same. Otherwise they will be treated as having failed in that subject.

It is informed that all private candidates who have not secured the minimum pass marks i.e., 40/50 in the practical examination in their previous appearance(s) should necessarily redo the practical examinations only if they have already passed in theory examinations. Candidates who have already passed in the Practical Examination should produce the evidence for the practical marks and handover the same to the Chief Superintendent of the Theory examination Centre concerned.

**2) Already Appeared in New Pattern (600 Marks)**

As per Government Order (2D) No.50, School Education (GE1) Department, Dated.09.08.2017, candidates should necessarily secure a minimum of 15 Marks out of 70 in Theory Examination and candidates must have appeared in practical examination and should have secured 35 marks out of 100 in the subjects involving practical, in order to pass the same. Candidates who have not appeared for practical examination, but secured 35 and above marks in theory examination and internal will be treated as failed in that subject.

Failed Candidates, who have secured 35 and above marks in theory examination and internal but not appeared in practical examination, should necessarily appear for practical examination only.

Failed Candidates, who have secured below 35 marks in theory examination and internal but not appeared in practical examination, should necessarily appear for both theory and practical examinations.

**REGARDING AURAL – ORAL SKILL TEST: (Candidates who have not already appeared for Oral skill test in old pattern)**

The Aural – Oral skill test will be conducted for 20 marks in Languages and Advanced Language (Tamil). The following category of candidates will be admitted for the above test:-
