Now the Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety in the reference 6th cited has requested the State to take action on the following additional directions.


S. No	Issues	Additional directions given by the SCCoRS
1.	Implementation of earlier directions	The Supreme Court Committee on Road Safety again directs the State to furnish the information if all the school buses and other vehicles transporting students to schools are displaying carrying capacity (both inside and out side of the vehicle) as per directions of SCCoRS

Accordingly, I am to request you to furnish the compliance report on the above-mentioned committees' observations and send the same to this office positively on or before 19.04.2023.
