Sub: School Education - 2024-25 - Block level Competition: Literary Club and Quiz Club - Instructions – regarding.

Ref: 1. Director of School Education Letter Rc.No.066737/ M1/S1/2024 dated 04.10.2024
2. Joint director (NSS) Letter Rc.No.066737/ M1/S1/2024 dated 24.10.2024

As per the reference letter (1) cited above, the school level competitions of literary club and quiz club for classes 6 to 9 shall be conducted, and the details of the participants and the winners are to be marked in EMIS. The winners of the school level literary and quiz club competitions from government schools shall participate in the block level competition.

Literary Club

The **Block-level literary club competition shall be held on 18.11.2024 and 19.11.2024 in all blocks.** Students from the government schools who have secured the first position across 8 type of literary club competitions held at school level shall participate in the block level literary club competitions. Details of the type of competition and criteria for awarding marks are as per table I&II given below.

The judges of each competition shall use the scoring sheet format given in Annexure I to award marks to the participants according to the criterias mentioned above. The marks awarded by all the 3 Judges shall be added and consolidated for all participants. The Winner will be the participant who scores the highest points.

Quiz Club

The school-level quiz club competition is in progress and the details of the participants and winners shall be entered in the EMIS portal. The date of entry is extended till 11.11.2024.

The two winning teams of school-level Quiz will participate as a single team of four students to represent their school at the block level quiz competition (based on content from Thenchittu magazine and newspaper)

Similarly, the two winning teams of school-level Quiz competition will participate as a single team of four students to represent their school at the block level quiz competition (based on current affairs and GK)

This process will result in a single team of four students for each type of competition, as mentioned in the table III below.

The judges of each competition shall use the scoring sheet format given in Annexure II to score the participants in the final round according to the criterias of awarding marks.

Instructions to conduct block level Competitions

One teacher from each school shall accompany students for the block level competitions. The Chief Educational Officers are to ensure a high / higher secondary school from the block is chosen as the venue for conducting the competition.

The number of judges needed, specific criteria for awarding marks and the guidelines to conduct each type of competition are outlined club wise, in the tables above. The Chief Educational Officers are to ensure that the correct number of judges and well qualified persons are selected and that they adhere to the criteria for awarding marks as stated.

The Block education officers/Deputy Inspectors are to ensure that the details of the winner are entered and upload the link to the video or PDF of the winner's artefact in EMIS, as mentioned in the table below.
