Sub Samagra Shiksha – Conduct of District-level quiz at HI-TECH
LABS in High Schools in selected 10 Districts-Instructions to
Chief Educational- Officers Reg.

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The State Project Directorate, Samagra Shiksha, School Education Department has planned to conduct a District-level quiz for about 1200 students of 11th Standard. The district-level quiz will be conducted for students who have been identified through the school-level quiz conducted through Hi-tech lab.

The district-level quiz will be conducted in 5 Hi-tech labs in High Schools located across the district. The district-level quiz will contain 15-20 questions based on the group and will be completed in 30 minutes. The questions will be based on group wise subjects for Class XI listed below -

- Physics
- Chemistry
- Mathematics
- Biology
- Computer Science
- Commerce
- Accountancy
- Economics
- Business Mathematics
- History
- Computer Applications

The district-level quiz will be conducted for Classes XI on the dates given in the table:

The Chief Educational Officers of the districts concerned are instructed to follow the given guidelines for the successful conduct of the District-level quiz.

- The Hi-tech lab in High schools should be highly functional, equipped with all the amenities required to conduct the district-level quiz i.e:
 1. 10 Computers
 2. Adequate power supply
 3. Internet connectivity should be stable
- 5 Hi-tech labs should be identified for the same, and an additional Hi-tech lab should be identified as a buffer centre, to be used in case of technical issues such as power cuts in any of the chosen Hi-tech labs. The Hi-tech labs should be selected by May 02, 2022.
- The CEO should make necessary plans with the **technical support of the District EMIS coordinators** for mapping the 1200 students with the Hi-tech lab centres based on practical logistical feasibility. It is to be ensured that the centres are chosen based on Educational Districts, and the distance travelled by students is minimised to the maximum extent possible.
- All weekly quiz scheduled for this week in the Hi – Tech labs are requested to be cancelled in the chosen head quarter schools alone, as the District Level Quiz for 11th will be conducted in these schools.
- The CEOs are instructed to **depute BRTEs** from 04.05.2022 to 06.05.2022 as **invigilators** to each HI –TECH Lab centres for the fair conduct of the quiz.
- The **HMs should be instructed to contact the students** and make necessary arrangements to bring them to the designated Hi-tech Labs at


the District Head quarters. The travel arrangements should be made such that students from schools nearer to the identified centres are assigned the first and last slots, and the students from farther away schools should be assigned to the slots in the middle of the day.


- The students should be informed in advance about the District-level quiz.
- The District-level quiz will be completed (in batches) for the 1200 students in each district within the stipulated 3 days (04.05.2022 to 06.05.2022). Each batch will be for 30 minutes and for 10 students. The time table is as follows :

- The Hi tech lab coordinator will organise the conduct of the District-level quiz. The Chief Educational Officers should depute one EDC to the Hi-tech lab centre to handle all logistics during the District-level quiz. Food and transportation is to be arranged for the same.
- **A team of DIET faculty** and officials will visit the Hi-tech lab centres in the District Headquarters **on all 3 days**.
- Students will carry only a pen/ pencil for the quiz. Sheets for working out will be provided in the Hi-tech lab, and collected from the student on completion of the quiz.
- Officials are requested to seat students in mixed groups and mediums to ensure smooth functioning of the quiz.
- Transport arrangements and the necessary logistics needed to bring the students to the selected Hi-tech Labs should be made by the Chief Educational Officers.
