General Instructions for Quiz

A quiz on the topic “The Constitution of India and National Symbols of Pride” is being organized for the students of classes 6th to 12th studying in any recognised school situated in India.

Syllabus:

The questions will be asked from themes encompassing “The Constitution of India and National Symbols of Pride.” Further, these may be based on universal values of **Humanity, Truth, Dignity, Equality, Justice, Fraternity, Liberty, and Indian Values** as depicted in the figures in the original document of Indian Constitution.

Examination Format & Selection in Next Rounds:

- For the students of classes 6th to 12th, the quiz will be conducted in three rounds. The first round will be conducted in participating school in pen paper mode. The school will check the papers and submit the result to Team Vishwaroop within 10 days of examination.
- Based upon the first round result the second round will be conducted on any mode (online or offline mode) but will be at the centre decided by the Vishwaroop Education team.
- All the students will be awarded by the Participation certificates.
- In the first two rounds, the questions will be in Multi-Choice Questions (MCD) format. The questions will be bilingual mode. The one language is English and other is regional language of such State.
- The third round will be conducted in electronic manner i.e. buzzer system at the place decided by the Vishwaroop Education team.
- The details for the third round will be communicated to the eligible students later.
- For the first two rounds, each correct answer will have 1 mark. There is no negative marking.
- For class 6 to 8, the total number of questions will be 40 and the duration will be 45 minutes whereas for class 9 to 12 the total number of questions will be 60 and the duration is 60 minutes.

Criteria for Second Round:

- **Round 1:** If there are 100 or less participants registered in one category then the school can send three participants for the second round for this category. If more than 100 participants are registered then the school will send 10 participants for every 100 participants for the second round. For example, if school will register 525 students, then school will send 52 students for second round. These participants will be the toppers of their school.
- **Round 2:** Only three participants from the second round will go to the third round. These three participants will be state toppers.

- **Round 3:** For the third round, three participants from each state across the country will take first, second and third place.
- The three top students, who got highest marks, from each state in each category will be qualified for the final round. They will be declared as State topper.

Criteria for Final Round:

- Only the State topper from each category will be eligible for the third round. The third-round students will be awarded an outstanding certificate and Cash Prizes declared.

Examination and Evaluation

- The first level examination will be held in the same school and will also be evaluated by the school. The school will send the marks sheet of all the participants along with the list of the second-round participants as per the registered number or the first-round examination.
- For the second-round examination, the participants will have to come to a centre decided by Vishwaroop Education. The 3 participants from state, who score the highest marks, will go to the third round. If more than three participants get same marks, a special examination will be conducted for them.
- The third round will be in electronic mode. Three participants from one state will have to come to the centre decided by Vishwaroop Education. Two persons (a parent, school teacher or principal) alongwith the student can stay. They will bear the transportation expenses for coming to the examination centre. The food, accommodation and everything will be free there.

Registration & Examination Schedule:

The schedule for registration is as under:

- The registration will be done through school only. The registration link of the Quiz is <https://olympiad.vishwaroopedu.com>
- The Examination fee for quiz is Rs.150/- per student out of which, Rs.25/- will be given to the participating school on account of administrative expenses.

- The award ceremony will be conducted on or after 14th April 2026.


Special Prize for Schools:
